Meeting Places

- Coordinated with city to arrange June 29th meeting with Ian Gray of MMM Group to present the 60-70% Turtle Design Drawings to city staff
- Attended June 29 meeting and took meeting notes and circulated to city representative and Ian Gray
- Circulated Turtle Design Drawings to the Joint Stewardship Board
- Followed up with Ian Gray to obtain budget for the design including contingency

Environmental Interpretive Centre

- On-going coordination between Scott Robinson and Cathy Capes, Architects Tillman Ruth Robinson (ATRR), and Peter Wobschall (City) to obtain digital data set showing NEC boundary for ATRR layering onto EIC site location drawings
- Follow-up with ATRR to request EIC Design servicing requirements for city investigation into regulations
- Initiated search for Capital Campaigns Fundraising consultants

Environmental Monitoring Medicines

 Reviewed medicine report and video clips from Traditional Medicine people's walkthrough of the valley to assess medicines in creek construction and maintenance area around golf course

- Coordination with City Manager, Rob Gatto to obtain drawings of Creek Construction (January and July 2015) to determine area for assessment and medicine recovery
- Met with Traditional Medicine People and created field plan with diagrams and aerial photos to document medicine assessment in construction area
- Coordinated with golf course superintendent Chris Anker who was very helpful in facilitating access for medicine people to conduct assessment
- Reviewed draft results and maps for medicine assessment before recovery recommendations and final report generation
- Obtained and reviewed video clips take by medicine people during assessment
- Connected with creek construction project manger Marco Oddi who was helpful and identified on the drawings recommended areas for medicine recovery – July construction postponed until November
- Followed up with medicine people to communicate revised construction area and timeframe and adjusted timeline for recovery
